*Bringing resources within reach
for non-profit special libraries*

Research in environment and conservation requires an unusual combination of resources. The **International Environment Library Consortium** was founded to provide access to array of resources in environment, ecology, wildlife, natural resources, business, and economics, and to make resources from major publishers affordable at the not-for-profit scale. The first consortium designed for non-academic institutions, the IELC was founded in 2009 as a cooperative licensing partnership, and will undertake new development projects over time for products and services that would benefit members. There is no membership fee at this time, though some costs are shared equally by all members.

Who can apply for membership? The IELC is open to not-for profit 501(c)(3) organizations or government agencies working in environmental conservation. We are unable to accept academic institutions or federal libraries at this time. To join, please contact the IELC Administrator for details:

BioOne provides a unique aggregation of high-impact bioscience research journals from independent society and organizational publishers in the biological sciences. The IELC offers BioOne's standard consortial discount of 10% off the list price for BioOne.1 or BioOne.1&2. BioOne.2 is not available on its own.



CABI produces key scientific publications: CAB Abstracts, multimedia compendia, books, ebooks and full text electronic resources aiming to further science and its application to real life. IELC members are eligible for a 15% discount on any CABI product, including Environmental Impact, Forest Science, Animal Science, etc. Members may elect to access CAB Abstracts via EBSCO, and can receive the discount on the CABI portion of the charge.



EBSCOhost® publishes more than 300 full text and secondary databases. The IELC offers a custom package of six full-text EBSCO databases at a significant discount, including Environment Complete, Sustainability Reference Center, Sustainability Watch, Non-Profit Organization Reference Center, Academic Search Complete, and Business Source Complete.



Ecological Society of America's suite of core peer-reviewed environmental journals, including Ecology, Ecological Applications, Ecological Monographs, and the open-access EcoSphere, are now published by Wiley. IELC members receive a discount off the full ESA package.



JSTOR is a not-for-profit digital archive of over one thousand academic journals and other scholarly content. IELC members receive a discount on the one-time Archive Capital Fee. Normal pricing applies for the Annual Access Fee, and members choose their own collections. Previous JSTOR customers may qualify for a credit when joining the IELC.

nature

Nature is the world's foremost international weekly journal for research, news, comment and opinion in the life sciences. IELC members receive a discount off the regular price for non-profit organizations. New subscribers receive access in the current year, plus an introductory three-year backfile. Additionally, the Nature Publishing Group's entire platform is accessible via the Articles on Demand Complete package.

Science is the world's leading weekly journal of original research, global news, and commentary in the general sciences. IELC members receive a discount off the regular price for non-profit organizations. Access includes all articles from 1997 to the present. Science Express and other AAAS publications can be added at an additional cost.



ScienceDirect® is one of the largest online collections of published scientific research in the world. The IELC deal includes access to 425 titles, 1995 to present, across four journal subject collections: Environmental Sciences; Agricultural and Biological Sciences; Veterinary Science and Veterinary Medicine; and Economics, Econometrics and Finance. Additional collections may be added depending on interest.



Springer is one of the leading publishers of journals, books, protocols, eReferences, and book series in the sciences. IELC members have access to three of Springer's major subject collections for journals and e-books, on the Springer for R&D platform: Biomedical & Life Sciences, Business & Economics, and Earth & Environmental Sciences. Access is to journal content 1997 to the present, and ownership of e-book content 2005-2011.
